40 councils successfully granted an exemption to extend recycling processing contracts to ensure continuity of service

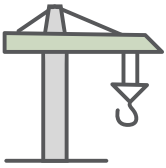

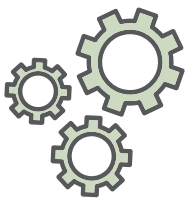

Delivering Recycling Victoria
